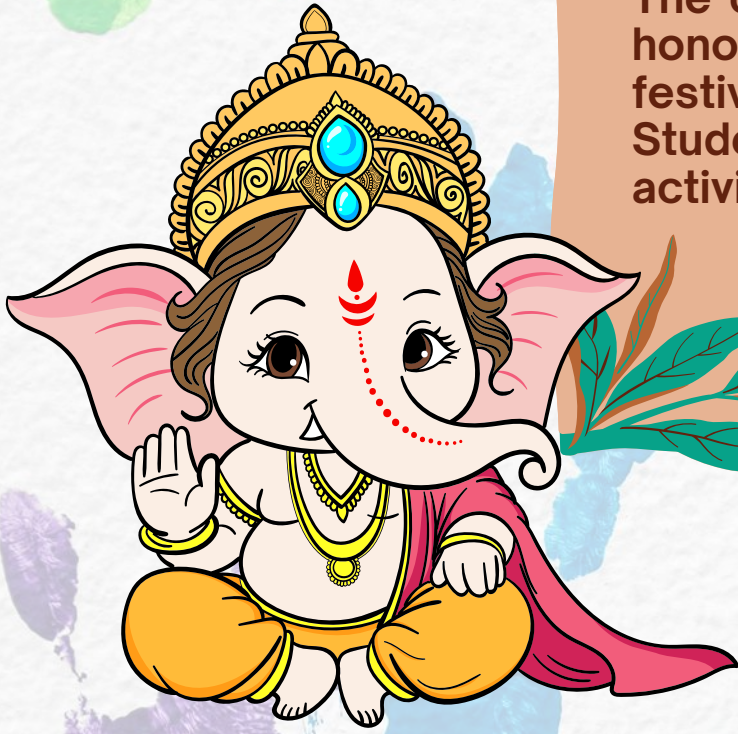

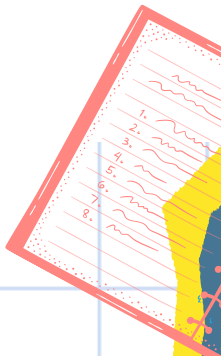
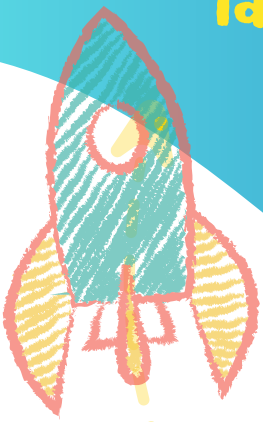
NURSERY GRADUATION DAY

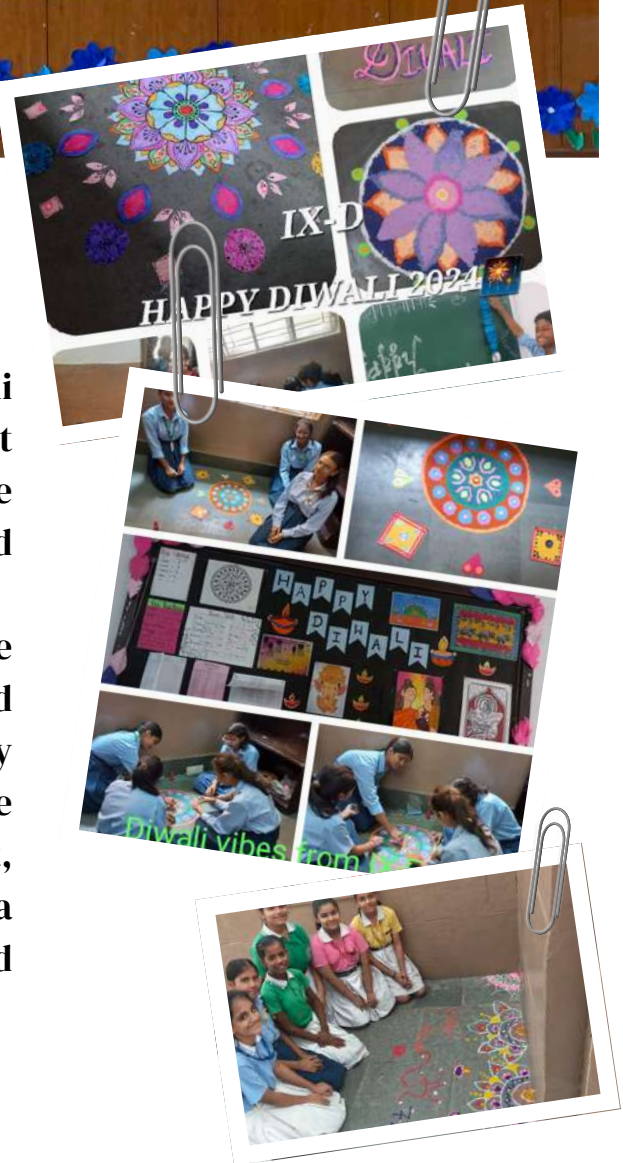
The Dusshera celebration was a resounding success, promoting cultural awareness, spiritual values and community bonding.
