Focusing on the theme the teachers planned craft (chick making) and mango mojito making activities.






Cheerful children attired in yellow outfits were sparkling with optimism, enlightenment and happiness.

MAGIC SHOW



POEM RECITATION (ENGLISH) WITH PROPS


Students of Class III enthusiastically participated in the recitation activity. They all came with various interesting and colour props that brought spark in their performance.

ECO-FRIENDLY JEWELLERY MAKING ACTIVITY



ONLINE WORKSHOPS AND WEBINARS


01. Stencil Painting on Fabric Workshop by Pidilite for the Students of Class III




TEACHER'S DAY


